**FORMAL ADVICE ON DECISION REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT:  
COMPLIANT**

*STRENGTHENING IMMUNISATION*

Thank you for providing your Decision Regulatory Impact Statement (DRIS) on the above proposal.

The DRIS provides a useful summary of consultation outcomes and demonstrates justification for the proposed legislative amendments. The analysis indicates how the preferred option will promote achievement of herd immunity for children enrolled in child care services and kindergarten programs in Western Australia. The document also incorporates a clear implementation and evaluation strategy.

It is apparent that development of the DRIS required assessment of a large amount of material provided by respondents, which presented multiple viewpoints and addressed sensitive issues.

Based on the information provided, the Better Regulation Unit (BRU) is satisfied that the DRIS meets the adequacy criteria outlined in the *Regulatory Impact Assessment Guidelines*.
